Archaism easily converts into a special personal advantage in sphere of sportive competition, and, what about modern public in general? We argue clear and simple, yet provocative points.

Definitely, "Future sport mega-events and other forms of festival capitalism will continue to attract diverse forms of opposition, criticism, and complaint" [3].
